

America At A Crossroad
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Today I would just like to talk about, “America is at a Crossroad.” Since we are part of America we are a part of where America is at. A remnant. Whenever a nation goes bad, as America has gone bad, there usually is a remnant of people who love the Lord. Even in the great flood there was just a small group: Noah’s family. But everyone else turned away to evil. Noah still loved the Lord. In the time of Jeremiah most of the people went bad and became wicked. But there was a remnant. Jeremiah was one of them. The Eunuch that saved him from the pit was one of them. Daniel and his friends were part of that remnant. There was a remnant that loved the Lord. But most of the people were judged. Today, America is like that. Most people are wicked but there is a remnant that still fear God. But we are part of this nation, so we will suffer with it. And we are to intercede for it.

America has created great abominations in God’s sight. Abortion, our ungodly schools; we have actually cast Christ out of our schools. Can you imagine that? It’s almost scary when you think about it. Can you imagine casting Christ out of our schools? Just imagine for a minute our schools at one point where Jesus freely walked the halls of our public schools and the teachers would pray and read His Bible and Christ had total freedom. And then one day the Supreme Court ordered him out, and the principal and the vice principal came and grabbed Jesus, and brought Him to the door, and cast him out and said, “You’re out of here. We don’t want you in here anymore. We forbid you to have any freedom or anything here. You’re out!” They threw Christ out of the schools. They wouldn’t let Him have any place or any room. They forbid

him. “We don’t want you to talk in the school. We won’t pray to you any more. We don’t want any part of you in our schools.” Now let me ask you a question. What’s God the Father think of that? This is one of those hideous crimes that any government can do: Cast Christ out of their schools. Especially a Christian nation. They abolish Christianity; same thing; abomination in the eyes of God.

Homosexual marriages. The idea of it makes me shudder. Supreme court forced on all 50 states they must marry homosexuals and legally give them a marriage license and proclaim their marriage legal. Abomination in the eyes of God. Only Sodom probably would do something like that right.

We worship money. Our coins say in God we trust. I’m glad it doesn’t say in money we trust. But we really trust in money. And what does the Bible say about the love of money? It is the root of all evil. All our corruption, even abortion, flows from the love of money.

And isn’t it amazing when they had that “Unplanned” movie, one of the major themes of that the abortion clinic was to make money. It was a major thing. Money, money, money. Kill the baby and make big bucks off of it. It makes me shudder. How wicked. These abortion clinics, every one of them should be shut down. And everybody who runs those clinics and the doctors should be put in jail and some of them executed for multiple homicides. Amen? That’s how evil they are. But yet our liberal Congress totally support and obsess to save abortion; to save this institution. So all the flow of wickedness, our Congress loving money and forsaking the American people. Ah... sexual sins unbelievable across America. And we could go on and on. America has become a wicked land. Wicked! Wicked!

Turn to Proverbs 6. I just want to show you what the Bible says. We forgot the Bible haven't we in America? We have some kind of a message but it's not coming from Scripture is it? They use Scripture but they use it for the feel good messages. We want to feel good, man, feel good at a time of great wickedness, abomination. We want to feel good. Don't bother my conscience. Don't bother me with my sin. Just make me feel; puff me up, make me feel good messages across America. Right now, today, probably thousands and thousands feel good messages in the churches, while our nation is headed for hell and destruction.

Proverbs 6:12-15

A naughty person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth. We have a lot of that don't we? Just a wicked mouth.

He winks with his eyes, he speaks with his feet, teaches with his fingers. Frowardness is in his heart.

Frowardness is another name for wickedness in his heart.

He devises mischief continually. He sows discord.

Oh we see that don't we by the liberal press and the liberal democrats. We also see it by the churches, the wicked churches.

Therefore shall his calamity come suddenly. Suddenly shall he be broken without remedy."

What does that say? These are these politicians, is it not, that we have in Washington today? This defines them. Frowardness or wickedness in his heart. He devises mischief continually and sows discord.

I'll tell you what, the liberal press and these communist liberals want to point a finger at the conservatives and say we are making division. We are not making division. The righteous conservative people in America who want to ban abortion, want God in our schools, and want to do what is right are not causing division. It is the wicked liberals with their wicked policies that are causing

division in the land. And they will be judged one day and suddenly.

Proverbs 6:16

These six things doth the Lord hate” yea, seven are an abomination unto Him:

Now our government has forgot God so therefore they no longer care what is an abomination to God. Right? They don't care. They do not evaluate things according to God's word and what is morally right. If God says something is an abomination it is morally wicked, is it not? Today we don't go by God's word. We call right wrong and wrong right today. We have such a wicked, wicked policy in America today. We have forsaken God and his word and the law of God and what is morally right. The Scripture teaches whatever God says is abomination is extremely evil in the eyes of the Lord and it should be evil in the eyes of America.

Amen? If we want his blessing. If we embrace these abominations what will we have coming from the Lord? We will experience his judgment. Amen? God will judge things that are abomination in his eyes. These are abominations:

A proud look. v17

Yes we are very proud in America. Very proud. It's an abomination. This is one of the problems. Mr. Trump, I love Mr. Trump, but when Mr. Trump gets up and says, "I have made America great in three years." Not only we started to make, now we've achieved: keep America great. He's implying that he has made America great with his economy policies. And he's forgotten God. I knew Trump would be humbled, eating turkey. But this is the problem with America. We're so proud. We are a proud people. We don't like to give glory to God. Look at how they have tried to erase the Providence of God from our history. Are we not proud? We want to say that we, some way, were so lucky, and we Americans were so resourceful, we beat the British on our own power. What a lie. Proud! Isn't this pride? Yes. And today we are

so proud. Abomination. America needs to humble itself and give glory to God and admit how He has been gracious to us and merciful.

A lying tongue. v17

Oh how God hates lying. Our liberal news are total liars; constantly lying. Our politicians are constantly lying. Americans have chosen the way of lying and deceit. And God hates it. He didn't just say that this is a sin. It's an abomination in the eyes of the Lord. What happened to integrity? It used to mean something. In Abe Lincoln's day it did. He was highly regarded (Abe) because he was such an honest man of integrity. I don't think we can find anybody in politics any more that are honest; even Republicans. I don't think they even value. . . I think they believe to be in politics you have to lie. That's what I believe has happened. And God says its abomination in his eyes.

In the pulpit. Preachers are filthy liars. They get up and lie about God all the time. And they are forked tongue all the time. They say one thing, do another; do one thing, and then lie about it. I mean constantly are the preachers this way. You wonder why so many people don't want to go to church. You have to speak the truth in love. Amen?

And look at the third one.

Hands that shed innocent blood. v17

How many babies are being killed? Over 60 million. Over two thousand a day are being killed in America. And what blows me away? Today, now it may change, last I heard 47 people have died in the past few weeks since this hit America: 47. Every day we are killing, yes killing, over two thousand. I think it was 2363 babies a day. Not a word. Matter of fact, do you know what they've done This is how evil they are in the eyes of God. They tried to sneak in federal money to help pay for abortions in this new bill that they

are pushing through, 8.3 billion dollars or whatever it was. Either that one or the second one. It might have been the second one. And Trump said, no, he doesn't want that abortion part in that bill. Can you imagine sneaking it in, in an emergency, to kill babies, when we are suppose to be saving lives. We are going to put a bill in there to kill the innocent. It's abomination in the eyes of the Lord. And God sees it. And they do have, what's that called (the Hyde Amendment) that says it is against the law for the federal government to fund abortion? There's a law like that. And they were going against the law to try to put this in.

Hands that shed innocent blood. v17

Where is the conscience in America today about abortion? I just shudder; I just shudder at this. You know we condemn Adolf Hitler. Adolf Hitler was an evil man, and one of the biggest things they say about it is the Jewish holocaust. He slaughtered six to seven million. He just killed them right off. Okay? And Americans hate Adolf Hitler. He is one of the worst evil dictators that ever lived in America's viewpoint. Our Supreme Court is behind the murder of 60 million human beings. But we don't hate the Supreme Court? We don't call them villains or evil oligarchy or dictators. Is our conscience dead? Yes it is in America. Abomination in the eyes of God.

A heart that diviseth wicked imaginations. v18

Amen? How much wicked imaginations do we see coming out of Washington. Look at this false impeachment. Wasn't that a wicked imagination? Was it not? To falsely impeach the President of the United States because they hate him? This is a wicked imagination brought into play. They actually did it. All these things that go down. The Russian hoax. Right? A wicked imagination. We see these things at a high level even. But how much more low levels do we see wicked imaginations going on in America. The transsexual thing where they are trying to make boys and girls go

in the same bathroom. Just wicked imaginations going on throughout the land. It's unbelievable.

Feet that be swift in running to mischief. v18

We have that don't we in this country? So much mischief.

A false witness that speaketh lies. v19

That was in the false impeachment. Right? False witnesses that speak lies. Goes on all the time in America. Abomination in the eyes of God.

And he that sows discord among brethren. v19

In our churches we see that. See it with my mom. She did it all the time. It was an abomination what she did. I believe that these liberal press and liberal Democrats are sowing discord in America. I do. Trying to bring division in America. Rather than embrace our Christian tradition. Amen? We should be united around Christianity and Christian morality; Americans should be. And there is a big portion that are. But these evil Democrats want to divide. They want to divide the nation by turning us from God. And we are going to read in a minute about what God says when people do it.

We are a Christian country and all of our government officials, all our preachers, all the people in leadership should be pointing people to Christ and Christianity and united around the Christian religion. This unites us more, yes, I'm gong to say this. This book, the Bible. We are a people of the Bible. This nation is here because of Scripture. We are a people of Christianity. There's nothing that more unites us together in America than the Bible and Christianity. I'm not talking about denominations now, I'm talking about pure Christianity. This is what holds America together more than the Constitution. Amen? Why does this hold us together for? Because this, even more than the Constitution, teaches us what is right and wrong. Amen? What is morally right and what is morally wrong. This Bible teaches us to exalt the law of the land and to live by it. Our faith in God, our Christianity keeps us righteous and because

of that we want to live by the Constitution. Do you see that? Why are we a law abiding people? Because the Constitution makes us a law abiding people? No. Christianity does and our faith in God does. And because of that we are united behind the Constitution because we are united in the Christian faith that teaches what is righteous and how to live.

When people turn us from our faith, when they turn us from Christianity, they are sowing discord in America. Amen? They are causing division. And they are instigating wicked policies against the foundation of this nation which is Christianity and the Christian God and they will bring God's wrath upon us. Because we are a Christian republic no matter what. Don't let anyone lie to you. We were born and came forth a Christian nation and Christianity is really what unites us together more than the Constitution. Can we not see that? Can we not see that? These people that reject Christianity, do we see them, what do they do with the Constitution? They throw it in the trash, don't they. And why do they do it for? Because they are a people gone lawless. They're without order. They don't believe in the law and why? Because they don't believe in Christ and Christianity. And they are trying to turn us from our God and our Christian faith down a path of wickedness. And when people rise up and say, no, we want to ban abortion. We want to believe in God. We want Christianity in our schools. Ah, they Hate us. We are white supremacists. We are oppressive. We are evil. They are wicked to the core and they sow discord. And they condemn those who want to bring us back to our foundation of Christianity.

We are more divided now than we ever were before the Civil War. Because the Civil War, as bad as it was, and the division was over slavery, but it was not over Christianity. It was not over basic Christian morality. Both the North and South still believed. They

just were divided about slavery and the extension of it or not, and succession, whether the states had the right. These are the two main things they were divided over. Today we are divided about a foundational thing, which is Christianity and Christian morality and whether we should believe in God or not, and follow Him or not, and follow this book or not. We're divided on a very foundational thing, even more so than slavery. And I don't know, as slavery brought God's wrath down upon us, what we are doing now will bring His wrath even ten times greater.

I remember that Thomas Jefferson...he said he feared and trembled, and he wasn't even a born again Christian, but he believed in the judgment of God and the fear of God. He said, "I fear and tremble at the wrath of God we are going to face because of slavery." He said, God's wrath is going to come down on us hard because of the vicious institute of slavery in America. What would he say today? A hundred times harder because of abortion which is much worse than slavery! And our casting Christ out of our schools? My word. Where was this done in the Bible? My. What did Jesus say? If they reject you and don't listen to the words of the gospel, it's more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that town. We are rejecting Jesus Christ in our schools and public institutions: God's wrath. But God doesn't wait till the Judgment Day. He judges nations now. He doesn't wait until the Judgment Day to judge nations. Now is the time. He will judge individuals there. He won't wait until then.

In Genesis 9 listen to what he says. In verse one:

Genesis 9:1

1 And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.

Be fruitful and multiply. Right there, have babies, don't kill them. Have babies. They were to reproduce and have many babies that were a blessing from the Lord. This is God's command. Abortion

is against it; flies in the face of God's command of life. And being fruitful.

Genesis 9:2-3

2 And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moveth upon the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered.

3 Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.

So all the meat now can be eaten instead of just green herbs.

4 But the flesh with the life thereof, which is the blood thereof, shall ye not eat.

In other words, you've got to take the blood out of it.

Genesis 9:5-7

5 And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man.

6 Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man.

7 And you, be ye fruitful, and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the earth, and multiply therein.

So he commands us to multiply to have many babies. Be fruitful, have many children. But notice what he says.

6 Whosoever sheds man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed. In the image of God made he man.

And he will require it. The beast that kills a man shall be killed.

And the hand of man's brother will I require the life of man.

Every man that kills a man, God requires that man to die. It's the law of God before Moses ever brought forth the ten commandments. He said, "I will require it." Every man that is killed; the murderer must die. He will require it. Death is the punishment for murdering a man and shedding his blood. How much more if its innocent blood? This is the law of God.

Sixty million babies have been slaughtered in America today. The law of God says sixty million people must die. First, the Supreme

Court, then the doctors, and then the mothers that slaughtered them. They must give their lives up according to God. If they aren't executed, it's only man's mercy on them. According to the law of God, does it not say here,

Genesis 9:6

6 Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man.

God's law says that when a human being is murdered a life must be forfeited. The murderer must give up his life. This is God's law. Blood for blood. Why? Because the human being is made in the image of God. He's not an animal. This is the law of God. This is not an American law. Abortion is legal. You can kill babies at will. And no one dies. But God's law still stands. So this is the word of God to government, is it not? Who is given the sword of God. Is it not? Murderers who deliberately kill and there are all types of second degree, manslaughter and all of this. God is talking about a deliberate murder. Premeditated murder here. There are all different levels of murder. This is premeditated and he said if you premeditate and kill somebody you must die. This is the law of God for people and for government.

Why am I making a big thing out of this? Because God expects the American government to put on trial the Supreme Court and all those who have killed these babies. And that blood should be spilt for justice, for the murder of these babies. That's what God requires. What if the government doesn't do it? What if they refuse to do it? Then God will do it. He will do it. It's better that the American government does it, and justice prevail. We don't want God to rise up in his anger and do it, do we?

Now I believe (Judges 20) the only thing that will appease God's wrath that's coming on America...I'm not going to read all this, because it gets so late if I read all the scriptures, but you can look it up and read some of it yourselves, Judges 20 and 21. Actually it

starts in Judges 19:16. There was a man with his concubine traveling back home (he went and got her and then he was traveling back home) to Ephraim.

16 And, behold, there came an old man from his work out of the field at even, which was also of mount Ephraim; and he sojourned in Gibeah: but the men of the place were Benjamites.

So he was in Gibeah where the Benjaminites were.

17 And when he had lifted up his eyes, he saw a wayfaring man in the street of the city: and the old man said, Whither goest thou? and whence comest thou?

He told the man to come and stay at his house. In verse 22,

Now as they were making their hearts merry, behold, the men of the city, certain sons of Belial, beset the house round about, and beat at the door, and spake to the master of the house, the old man, saying, Bring forth the man that came into thine house, that we may know him.

In other words, they want to rape him homosexually.

23 And the man, the master of the house, went out unto them, and said unto them, Nay, my brethren, nay, I pray you, do not so wickedly; seeing that this man is come into mine house, do not this folly.

24 Behold, here is my daughter a maiden, and his concubine; them I will bring out now, and humble ye them, and do with them what seemeth good unto you: but unto this man do not so vile a thing.

25 But the men would not hearken to him: so the man took his concubine, and brought her forth unto them; and they knew her,

They abused her. They raped her,

and abused her all the night until the morning: and when the day began to spring, they let her go.

26 Then came the woman in the dawning of the day, and fell down at the door of the man's house where her lord was, till it was light.

27 And her lord rose up in the morning, and opened the doors of the house, and went out to go his way: and, behold, the woman his concubine was fallen down at the door of the house, and her hands were upon the threshold.

28 And he said unto her, Up, and let us be going. But none answered. Then the man took her up upon an ass, and the man rose up, and gat him unto his place.

So he went to Ephraim.

29 And when he was come into his house, he took a knife, and laid hold on his concubine, and divided her, together with her bones, into twelve pieces, and sent her into all the coasts of Israel.

30 And it was so, that all that saw it said, There was no such deed done nor seen from the day that the children of Israel came up out of the land of Egypt unto this day: consider of it, take advice, and speak your minds.

So he cut her up into twelve pieces, because these “sons of Belial,” these Benjaminites raped her and then killed her. One person now. I just want you to know. This is one person that was raped by homosexuals that wanted to rape the man, but they raped her, this concubine, a young gal. He cut her up and sent her throughout Israel and probably wrote notes. I imagine he wrote notes with all the donkeys he sent with the body parts saying what this is all about. So Israel comes together in Chapter 20.

Then all the children of Israel went out, and the congregation was gathered together as one man, from Dan even to Beersheba, with the land of Gilead, unto the LORD in Mizpeh. And the chief of all the people, even of all the tribes of Israel, presented themselves in the assembly of the people of God, four hundred thousand footmen that drew sword. (Now the children of Benjamin heard that the children of Israel were gone up to Mizpeh.) Then said the children of Israel, Tell us, how was this wickedness? And the Levite, the husband of the woman,

So he was a Levite.

the husband of the woman that was slain, answered and said, I came into Gibeah that belongeth to Benjamin, I and my concubine, to lodge.

Now back then you could have more than one wife, so this was like a second wife to him.

And the men of Gibeah rose against me, and beset the house round about upon me by night, and thought to have slain me: and my concubine have they forced, that she is dead.

6 And I took my concubine, and cut her in pieces, and sent her throughout all the country of the inheritance of Israel: for they have committed lewdness and folly in Israel.

7 Behold, ye are all children of Israel; give here your advice and counsel.

8 And all the people arose as one man, saying, We will not any of us go to his tent, neither will we any of us turn into his house.

9 But now this shall be the thing which we will do to Gibeah; we will go up by lot against it;

10 And we will take ten men of an hundred throughout all the tribes of Israel, and an hundred of a thousand, and a thousand out of ten thousand, to fetch victual for the people, that they may do, when they come to Gibeah of Benjamin, according to all the folly that they have wrought in Israel.

11 So all the men of Israel were gathered against the city, knit together as one man.

Now its interesting to me, at this point, Israel was a righteous land, a righteous country. They would not permit these Benjaminites to get away with this folly. There must be judgment against them. Remember the law of God? If you kill a human being, you must die for it. And they were going to go by the law, plus, it says in the law of Moses besides, "Thou shalt not murder." So they were going to do God's will and do justice. And this is just one life that has been abused and slaughtered by these evil men. Just one life. Why were they going to do this for? They feared God, amen? If they let this folly continue in Israel, the wrath of God would be on them all, amen?

Proverbs 20:1

And the tribes of Israel sent men through all the tribe of Benjamin, saying, What wickedness is this that is done among you?

See that. They want to know this wickedness that is done among you, the tribe.

Now therefore deliver us the men, the children of Belial, which are in Gibeah, that we may put them to death, and put away evil from Israel. But the children of Benjamin would not hearken to the voice of their brethren the children of Israel:

14 But the children of Benjamin gathered themselves together out of the cities unto Gibeah, to go out to battle against the children of Israel.

15 And the children of Benjamin were numbered at that time out of the cities twenty and six thousand men that drew sword, beside the inhabitants of Gibeah, which were numbered seven hundred chosen men.

Twenty-six thousand men sided with wickedness. There are only a few sons of Belial Benjaminites. What should they have done? They should have delivered them over and said, “Yes, execute them. We do not want this folly in Benjamin either.” But they did not! They did not!

Among all this people there were seven hundred chosen men lefthanded; every one could sling stones at an hair breadth, and not miss.

17 And the men of Israel, beside Benjamin, were numbered four hundred thousand men that drew sword: all these were men of war.

People, today your pro-abortion people, yes, your anti God people in America, are represented by the tribe of Benjamin. Yes. (39:57) The Supreme Court, all these Congress people that are sneaking abortion payments to kill babies, they have committed a folly in America; worse than these sons of Belial that raped and killed this concubine. Yes, they are like the tribe of Benjamin in America. And yet what does the rest of America do? Do we call folly? Do we rise up with righteous indignation and want to rid us of these wicked people that kill babies? No...no. We sit back and let them slaughter the unborn. The Bible teaches us that in America today the only way that we can avert the almighty wrath of an angry God on America we must rise up against the Benjaminites. We must call them out for their wickedness; and if they say we're going to side with the abortion clinics and abortion doctors and you're going to side with them, then we must deal with all of you.

I tell you the truth, America is at a crossroads and they don't even know it, but it's going to come to a head. You watch. It will. And

the truth will come out. Either we rid ourselves of these wicked people...yes...yes...We put the Supreme Court up for murder and all the doctors and mothers that have killed their babies. We bring them into court; we arrest them; and they must pay for their crime. And we put away folly from America. We put God back in the school and we judge the Supreme Court on this abomination, too. If we do not; if we do not; if we do not...yes, it will mean a civil war. Yes, it will. If we do not. If we sit back and do nothing and let these babies be massacred by the millions and the millions and the millions and think we can get away with it, we are the most stupid, foolish nation that has ever lived, besides Rome, and besides the nation of Israel in Jeremiah's time.

The Scriptures teach us, yes, civil war. In America we had civil war over abortion (slavery) and to keep the Union. We fought a war. Lincoln said, "No. You will not walk away. You will not split this nation. We will keep you and will fight to preserve the Union," and eventually said, "We will also fight to free slaves, because it's abomination in the eyes of God." Yes, it turned into a war to free slaves, too. It was fought and six to seven hundred thousand men died, millions were wounded, but in the end, it was God's judgment on us in a sense, but we never had to face the full wrath of God from an outside country coming in at least. And so we saved millions of lives, cause we fought a civil war. Because I tell you right now, if we had not fought that war, there had been another war and there had been a lot more Americans die to abolish slavery.

See what happens? Read about this. They go up and fight and you know what happens? They ask council of God. In 18,
Judges 20:18-22

And the children of Israel arose, and went up to the house of God, and asked counsel of God, and said, Which of us shall go up first to the

battle against the children of Benjamin? And the LORD said, Judah shall go up first.”

God says, ‘Yes.’ Amen? ‘You go fight these Benjaminites. Yes, you go fight them even if you have to destroy them all.’ That’s what God says to them. And they go out to fight them and guess what happens?

Judges 20

And the men of Israel went out to battle against Benjamin; and the men of Israel put themselves in array to fight against them at Gibeah.

21 And the children of Benjamin came forth out of Gibeah, and destroyed down to the ground of the Israelites that day twenty and two thousand men.

22 And the people the men of Israel encouraged themselves, and set their battle again in array in the place where they put themselves in array the first day.

23 (And the children of Israel went up and wept before the LORD until even, and asked counsel of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up again to battle against the children of Benjamin my brother? And the LORD said, Go up against him.)

Twenty-two thousand Israelites, good guys died. Good guys died. And in the Civil War, there were many hundreds of thousands Northern soldiers died, yes, good guys, who hated slavery and loved the Union. There is a cost, is there not? There is a cost, a price for liberty.

We say in America all the time, “There is a cost and price for liberty.” There is a cost and price, and one of the things about liberty is this. When we have true liberty; true liberty, true justice and the blessing of God, amen. To fight for liberty against these ungodly, pro-abortion people, who slaughter the American people, to fight, some of us will die. But I tell you right now, we will lose all liberty, all our liberties, if we allow “Benjamin,” these anti-God pro-abortion people, if we let them continue on in this land doing their wickedness until when? Until Christ comes? I tell you right now, we will face the full wrath of the Almighty against America.

It is either a civil war to put down Benjamin or sit back and let Benjamin wreak havoc in America and continue indefinitely until God says, “Okay, if you will not do it, then I will do it.” And if God does it, many more will die. This is America’s choice!

I’m sorry I get worked up, but I’m telling you, people do not understand how our sins are piling up. This was one woman, one woman, a concubine. They rose up and God said, “Go, fight them, and even if you have to destroy them.” For one life. One life. What does God say for over 60 million?! You say, “Oh, America will never do that.” Okay, then let us tremble. Let us tremble in our hearts. Let us tremble to the bone. If we won’t do this then God will, and we will see millions upon millions of Americans slaughtered by the destruction God will bring upon America. Amen? God is not dead.

And they cried out to God and asked him, shall we go up. They wept, we’ve lost.

Judges 20:23

23 (And the children of Israel went up and wept before the LORD until even, and asked counsel of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up again to battle against the children of Benjamin my brother? And the LORD said, Go up against him.)

And they went up against them. And they destroyed the Israelites again, 18,000 men. Then all the people went and wept before the Lord and fasted. Look at this. These Israelites haven’t even done anything wrong and they are fasting in the middle of this...this a civil war in Israel, people. A civil war is happening right now and so far 22 + 18, forty thousand Israelites have died in the civil war and Benjamin seems to be getting off.

Judges 20:27-28

27 And the children of Israel enquired of the LORD, (for the ark of the covenant of God was there in those days,

28 And Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron, stood before it in those days,) saying, Shall I yet again go out to battle against the

children of Benjamin my brother, or shall I cease? And the LORD said, Go up; for to morrow I will deliver them into thine hand.

The fought them and they set a trap for them, and you know what? They almost killed them all. In verse 39,

Judges 20:39-48

39 And when the men of Israel retired in the battle, Benjamin began to smite and kill of the men of Israel about thirty persons: for they said, Surely they are smitten down before us, as in the first battle.

40 But when the flame began to arise up out of the city with a pillar of smoke, the Benjamites looked behind them, and, behold, the flame of the city ascended up to heaven.

41 And when the men of Israel turned again, the men of Benjamin were amazed: for they saw that evil was come upon them.

42 Therefore they turned their backs before the men of Israel unto the way of the wilderness; but the battle overtook them; and them which came out of the cities they destroyed in the midst of them.

43 Thus they inclosed the Benjamites round about, and chased them, and trode them down with ease over against Gibeah toward the sunrising.

44 And there fell of Benjamin eighteen thousand men;”

Remember, the tribe isn't that big hardly.

all these were men of valour.

45 And they turned and fled toward the wilderness unto the rock of Rimmon: and they gleaned of them in the highways five thousand men; and pursued hard after them unto Gidom, and slew two thousand men of them.

46 So that all which fell that day of Benjamin were twenty and five thousand men that drew the sword; all these were men of valour.

47 But six hundred men turned and fled to the wilderness unto the rock Rimmon, and abode in the rock Rimmon four months.

48 And the men of Israel turned again upon the children of Benjamin, and smote them with the edge of the sword, as well the men of every city, as the beast, and all that came to hand: also they set on fire all the cities that they came to.

They killed almost all the men of Benjamin. Only six hundred were left. Why? Was it Israel's fault? Whose fault was it that

Benjamin was almost wiped out? Was it Israel's fault? It was Benjamin. They chose evil; abomination in the eyes of the Lord and they had to be wiped out. Amen?

Now you say, "That's pretty harsh." That's kind of what happened in the Civil War, wasn't it? How many confederate men had to be killed and die because they had turned their face against the Almighty and they were fighting for the abomination of the institute of slavery, and they were willing to kill for it. They chose evil in the Civil War. And the North could never understand, "Why would you kill people over slavery?" But they did. We had to fight 'em. Let me ask you a question, why would the Benjaminites support these sons of Belial, and support them in raping and killing this concubine? No, you're not going to touch our people. We would rather kill you than let you touch these evil people. This is the evil we are facing in these pro-abortion people. They are wicked to the bone. And there is no other way. I do not think there is any other way, but a civil war. Nothing else will stamp them out. You say, "Oh, that's hateful." I want to tell you what...No! What is hateful is the slaughter of 60 million American babies! That is what is hateful. "Oh, this is terrible to have a civil war. We don't want division." What if Israel has said this about Benjamin? "Oh, this is terrible. This is terrible. We don't want division. We don't want division. We are just going to let the Benjaminites get away with it, and we're going to let them be. We don't want division. We don't want a civil war in Israel." What if they had chose that? Do you think they would escape the wrath of God? No, God would come down on all Israel. That's why they did this. They feared God.

We don't fear God anymore. We don't fear the Lord, but does that change God? Does God say, "Oh, Americans don't believe in me

anymore so I'm not going to judge them." He'll judge us even worse, won't He?

We have a choice to make, and this is our choice: either we rise up; and I have decided this is the choice America has to make. You are saying, "Can't we do this through peaceful legislation?" Do you really believe that these people will allow peaceful legislation? Do you really believe that it will ever be? I don't think there is any other course. I'll tell you right now, if a party rises up and bans abortion there will be civil war. I guarantee it. The people will rise up as one force (these wicked people), take their guns and start killing. I guarantee it. That is how blood thirsty they are over abortion. We just had a Senator stand outside the Supreme Court and threaten (a Senator), and they had not even touched anything on abortion. It was just a minor thing. It had something to do with the fact that doctors from a nearby hospital would be able to come in and check out abortion clinics. That's just about it. Had nothing to do with banning it. And they were upset and threatening the Supreme Court and had a crowd out there. What would they do if they ban abortion? That's why the Supreme Court will never do it. But I'm not saying it can't be done. And I'm not saying one day there won't be a party that will push it through. But I tell you what, I believe it will cause a civil war. I really do. And I think they will even threaten it. And the men of this party will have to have enough courage to say, "If it ignites a civil war, then so be it. Let's be ready for it." That's what they're gonna have to do. Just like Lincoln. Did Lincoln turn around and give up his conviction against the expansion of slavery just because they threatened to leave the Union and even war? No, he did not. Neither can we.

Now I want to give you hope for those of us who will be here, because America may not choose a civil war. They may choose to

let God judge us like they did in Jeremiah's time. They just chose God's wrath. Turn to Ezekiel 7:1-3.

- 1 Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
- 2 Also, thou son of man, thus saith the Lord GOD unto the land of Israel; An end, the end is come upon the four corners of the land.
- 3 Now is the end come upon thee, and I will send mine anger upon thee, and will judge thee according to thy ways, and will recompense upon thee all thine abominations."

This is a pronouncement upon Israel because they will not have a civil war and not clean up themselves. They have chosen to unite in evil and allow evil to continue through the land, so God has to judge them Himself.

Ezekiel 7:4-6

- 4 And mine eye shall not spare thee, neither will I have pity: but I will recompense thy ways upon thee, and thine abominations.

We just talked about them, did we not? America has abominations.

Ezekiel 7:4-8

- 4 And mine eye shall not spare thee, neither will I have pity: but I will recompense thy ways upon thee, and thine abominations shall be in the midst of thee: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.
- 5 Thus saith the Lord GOD; An evil, an only evil, behold, is come.
- 6 An end is come, the end is come: it watcheth for thee; behold, it is come.
- 7 The morning is come unto thee, O thou that dwellest in the land: the time is come, the day of trouble is near, and not the sounding again of the mountains.
- 8 Now will I shortly pour out my fury upon thee, and accomplish mine anger upon thee: and I will judge thee according to thy ways, and will recompense thee for all thine abominations.

The word, 'abominations' is used over and over again. In America today we have many abominations, Amen? If we do not have a civil war to put down these evil Benjaminites of America, then we will face the wrath of God like Judah did and this is why I'm reading this to you. This is what America is going to face if Americans do not rise up and put down this tribe of Benjamin in America; wicked tribe.

Ezekiel 7:9

9 And mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: I will recompense thee according to thy ways and thine abominations that are in the midst of thee; and ye shall know that I am the LORD that smiteth.

In other words, if we do not, in a sense, “smite” or put down these people to stop them from their evil and bring them to justice, yes, some of them have to be punished for murder, if we don’t do it, God will do it. And this is what’s happening in Judah. They did not try to cleanse the land. They did not fear God. They thought God would never ever, ever judge them. America is the same way. “Oh, we’re not wicked. God will never ever judge us. We are the good guys.” Israel thought the same thing. “We are the good guys. We’re God’s people. We’re special. God will never judge us. God will never judge us.”

America is deluded. He will judge us.

Ezekiel 7:10-15

10 Behold the day, behold, it is come: the morning is gone forth; the rod hath blossomed, pride hath budded.

11 Violence is risen up into a rod of wickedness: none of them shall remain, nor of their multitude, nor of any of theirs: neither shall there be wailing for them.

12 The time is come, the day draweth near: let not the buyer rejoice, nor the seller mourn: for wrath is upon all the multitude thereof.

13 For the seller shall not return to that which is sold, although they were yet alive: for the vision is touching the whole multitude thereof, which shall not return; neither shall any strengthen himself in the iniquity of his life.

14 They have blown the trumpet, even to make all ready; but none goeth to the battle: for my wrath is upon all the multitude thereof.

15 The sword is without, and the pestilence and the famine within: he that is in the field shall die with the sword; and he that is in the city, famine and pestilence shall devour him.”

Three outpourings of judgment upon Judea. What are they? Pestilence, famine, and sword. These can hit America, too.

Pestilence, famine, and sword. That's what hit Judea; wiped out most of the people.

The same thing could happen to America today. I think we have a bigger remnant of people in America than Judea did, but I believe there can be a three fold judgment hit America. This Corona virus could easily be the first fold coming down on us. And not just us, but China and Europe. Many times He judges other nations, too, when he judges us. He did that with Judea. God did not just judge Judea. He used Nebuchadnezzar to judge many nations, but He judged Judea, too.

Ezekiel 7:16-19

16 But they that escape of them shall escape, and shall be on the mountains like doves of the valleys, all of them mourning, every one for his iniquity.

17 All hands shall be feeble, and all knees shall be weak as water.

18 They shall also gird themselves with sackcloth, and horror shall cover them; and shame shall be upon all faces, and baldness upon all their heads.

19 They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of the LORD: they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumblingblock of their iniquity.

Did you hear that, "the silver and the gold shall not deliver them." Today we are going to fight the Corona virus with money. Trump is pulling all the money he can. And I don't blame him. We want to fight this thing as much as we can. But I want to tell you something, when God gets severe in His judgment, Corona virus is not; it could be much more severe. But in this wrath that came on Judea it was so severe, that no amount of money could save them from it. We think that money can fix up everything. It cannot.

We think science can fix up everything. It cannot. When the wrath of God hits us, and this is not a hard hit, but I think it is a hit from

God, but it can get much more severe, cause God is trying to wake up America. He will try a wake up. And then He will judge us severely.

Ezekiel 7:20-22

20 As for the beauty of his ornament, he set it in majesty: but they made the images of their abominations and of their detestable things therein: therefore have I set it far from them.

21 And I will give it into the hands of the strangers for a prey, and to the wicked of the earth for a spoil; and they shall pollute it.

22 My face will I turn also from them, and they shall pollute my secret place: for the robbers shall enter into it, and defile it.

They will defile the temple.

Ezekiel 7:23-25

23 Make a chain: for the land is full of bloody crimes, and the city is full of violence.

24 Wherefore I will bring the worst of the heathen, and they shall possess their houses: I will also make the pomp of the strong to cease; and their holy places shall be defiled.

25 Destruction cometh; and they shall seek peace, and there shall be none.

That's what's going to happen to America. Destruction will come.

Ezekiel 7:26-27

26 Mischief shall come upon mischief, and rumour shall be upon rumour; then shall they seek a vision of the prophet; but the law shall perish from the priest, and counsel from the ancients.

27 The king shall mourn, and the prince shall be clothed with desolation, and the hands of the people of the land shall be troubled: I will do unto them after their way, and according to their deserts will I judge them; and they shall know that I am the LORD.

This is the terrible judgment pronounced against Judea for all its abominations. God said, "I will judge them."

Now look at this. If you turn to nine I want to give you comfort in the middle of all this. Comfort for God's people. Chapter 9

1 He cried also in mine ears with a loud voice, saying, Cause them that have charge over the city to draw near, even every man with his destroying weapon in his hand.

2 And, behold, six men came from the way of the higher gate, which lieth toward the north, and every man a slaughter weapon in his hand; and one man among them was clothed with linen, with a writer's inkhorn by his side: and they went in, and stood beside the brasen altar.

3 And the glory of the God of Israel was gone up from the cherub, whereupon he was, to the threshold of the house. And he called to the man clothed with linen, which had the writer's inkhorn by his side;

4 And the LORD said unto him, Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a mark upon the foreheads of the men that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof.

Find the people that sigh and cry and grieve over the abominations of Israel and mark them. Set a mark on them.

Ezekiel 9:5-6

“5 And to the others he said in mine hearing, Go ye after him through the city, and smite: let not your eye spare, neither have ye pity:

6 Slay utterly old and young, both maids, and little children, and women: but come not near any man upon whom is the mark; and begin at my sanctuary. Then they began at the ancient men which were before the house.

Mark those. And who were the righteous? Who were the righteous that were being marked? Who were the righteous? “that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done” in the midst of Jerusalem. God will mark us. Put a mark on us in the time of judgment because we’re grieved and cry over all the babies being destroyed and murdered; and our schools and our children being driven from God. There is a sorrow in our hearts about all of this. He will mark us, the righteous. Amen. The righteous that are grieved about the abominations in America. Not the religious; the righteous.

Ezekiel 9:7-9

7 And he said unto them, Defile the house, and fill the courts with the slain: go ye forth. And they went forth, and slew in the city.

8 And it came to pass, while they were slaying them, and I was left, that I fell upon my face, and cried, and said, Ah Lord GOD! wilt thou destroy all the residue of Israel in thy pouring out of thy fury upon Jerusalem?

9 Then said he unto me, The iniquity of the house of Israel and Judah is exceeding great, and the land is full of blood,

Yes, is it not full of blood? The blood of the innocents.

and the city full of perverseness: for they say, The LORD hath forsaken the earth, and the LORD seeth not.

They say, "The Lord doesn't see. God doesn't see the slaughter of the unborn. He doesn't see what we are doing to our children." No. They think God is dead.

10 And as for me also, mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity, but I will recompense their way upon their head.

11 And, behold, the man clothed with linen, which had the inkhorn by his side, reported the matter, saying, I have done as thou hast commanded me.

He marked every man. People, if you love the Lord and you are grieved about the abominations of America and you cry and have great sorrow because all of this abomination, God will mark you when the judgment comes.

Turn to Psalm 91. And this is God's promise to us when we go through the time of God's judgment...sometimes we do. And I think America will either be a civil war or it will be the hand of God, outright, direct, coming through to judge America for the abominations of this country. We say, "God is dead." We say that He doesn't see if He is there. He doesn't care. He does care. He cares greatly. These are His babies and we are slaughtering them by the millions. I just watch the news and I'm thinking. . . and this Corona virus, they are trying to say up to a million people could die. So far 47 have died and they are trying to save as many lives as possible, and they never mention, every day 2,000 (+) babies are

slaughtered. How much is that in one week? Twenty thousand? It's almost 800,000 a year, and the best we can do is stop babies being killed the 3rd trimester, but the 1st trimester, go ahead. Kill the babies. Not a word is spoken except the part of the bill to fund abortion. That's it. But we don't mention the victims of abortion. I was surprised I even got that out of one gal. She said there are 2,363 a day being killed. That's unusual to ever hear that on the news. And that was only because a Senator was blasting the Supreme Court when they brought up the abortion issue. But they do not bring it up, because our conscience is almost dead. Even Tucker (Carlson), he brings up so many great things. He says we should be concerned about this virus. He's right, but he will not hammer on abortion, which is the greatest wickedness, and our schools, of all going on. Won't hammer on these things. Nobody dare, right? We don't want to hammer on it because we might lose our job, right? So powerful are the forces of wickedness in our land, Amen?

Listen to this promise. This is a great comfort.

Psalm 91:1-3

- 1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- 2 I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
- 3 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

The pestilence is exactly what the Corona virus is. It's a pestilence. It's a mighty disease, sweeping the country, killing many, many people. It says here, he will what? Deliver us. He will save us from pestilence, Amen? He will be our refuge. We will hide in the Lord under his wings. Amen?

Psalm 91:4

- 4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.

We will find a refuge, a fortress under the wings of Christ and he will protect us from this Corona virus and all the judgments that come upon the earth directly from God. But mark my word, if it's a bloody civil war, some of us will die. We have to die if we're going to fight for liberty, for freedom, just as the Israelites died fighting against Benjamin. Some of us will have to die, like they did in the Civil War; good men, good men. But if God's judgment and wrath hits the country, he will protect us from his wrath because we're his people. But the wrath will be much greater than a civil war would be.

Psalm 91:5-6

5 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

6 Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

So he's talking about war here, the arrow that flies, the bullet that flies, the weapons of military that shoot; the bombs that go off and destroy. He said, "You will not be afraid." You will not be afraid of war or pestilence (that is happening now).

Psalm 91:7

7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.

So this is war. People are dying; a thousand here, ten thousand over hear, but God will protect us.

Yes, war can come to America. If we don't have a civil war, we will have an outside war of great destruction and millions will die, but it is our choice. It is our choice, what we will do. But if war comes from the outside, God will protect us, and even in civil war he will, except if we are called to give our life, to free the babies.

Psalm 91:8

8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.

There it is, the reward of the wicked. It will be the judgment upon America. We will see it, but we won't experience it because God will keep us.

Psalm 91:9

9 Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

We have made him our refuge and he will protect us.

Psalm 91:10

10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

This is a plague, this corona virus. "Will not come nigh thy dwelling." He will protect us and no evil, no part of this judgment will befall us.

Psalm 91:11-12

11 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways.

12 They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

The angels will protect us and camp about the godly, even in the time of war. And what did we just see? The angel marked the godly that they would not be slain with the wicked. We just read that in Ezekiel, how God works this way.

Psalm 91:13

13 Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

We will overcome Satan, amen, even in the midst of all of this we can overcome the devil. We can overcome those enemies of God in America. Sometime, for us to ban abortion, we must overcome them, by the grace of God. There is no way that a Constitutional Amendment will ever be written without overcoming these evil people. There has to be an overcoming of them.

Psalm 91:14

14 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name.

Amen, because we love him, amen? “He set his love,” because we love the Lord he will deliver us; not because we are religious, but because we love the Lord and we try to live by faith in him.

Psalm 91:15

15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

This is great trouble when God’s judgment comes.

Psalm 91:15-16

15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

16 With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

Hallelujah. That’s a great psalm of comfort. You can read it over and over again. As I believe God will deal with America. We can have that faith and comfort in the Lord, amen?

Let’s pray. Dear Lord, thank you for your word to us. We pray that we will stand with you in these days of evil, and I think this corona virus is just one of many judgments that you will pour out on America. Lord, I don’t know what Americans will choose, but I pray that, Lord, whether we choose to rid ourselves of this tribe of Benjamin, or these pro-abortion, evil, abominable people, or whether you must bring judgment upon us, we pray that you would keep us safe under your wings. That you would be our refuge, a fortress for us, Lord God, as you purge the land of abominations. Just this blood thirsty, shedding of blood across the land. That you, O God, would protect your people. Mark us as your very own. Watch over us, Lord Jesus, and bless us in the middle of it all. Encourage our hearts with your love and comfort and help us, Lord Jesus, stand with you in this time. For our prayer is that you would cleanse the land of abominations. That’s what we pray. That this abortion will not go on indefinitely, Lord, generation after generation. Do not let us do it, Lord, It will destroy us to the bone. There will be nothing left of us. Oh, God, raise up a standard against this evil. Cleanse this land of this abomination and set us

back on Christianity again, the foundation of Christianity and Christian morality, that we might truly be a free people. For it seems like we are coming under more and more bondage, Lord, because we do not rid ourselves of the Benjaminites. And we just pray you will help us, help Americans. We need your help. We cry out to you for mercy and help and wisdom and guidance, Lord. And we pray that you keep us, again, safe under your hand, your wings, under this time of judgment. That you will give us great faith and even joy as we trust in you. That you will bless us, in spite of all that is happening. And we give you praise, in Jesus name, amen.
