Dear Mr. President Trump,

I wanted to write to you to express my gratitude for your service and to share some of my concerns with you. I am a Preacher of the Gospel and a carpenter. I live in Rice Lake, WI and am a great supporter of you as President. First, I want to thank you for standing for the people and the Constitution against communist policies about: the border crisis, abortion, free speech, 2nd Amendment, economy and being a nation under God. You are a patriot and we love you for it.

But I am concerned about your new campaign slogan – “Keep America Great’. Your old one is better: “Make America Great Again.” You assume America is great now because you have helped boost the economy with more jobs and businesses. You believe we are great because we are wealthy again. Our wealth is not what makes America Great. America is great because we are a Christian Republic that believes in and practices the Christian principles of liberty and righteousness. We are great because of our Christian heritage of freedom that our forefathers passed on to us. We are great because we have a free self-governing Nation with a government that is to protect and maintain that all Americans live in Liberty; that all men are created equal under God and have a right to live in liberty. We are great because we believe in living righteously by Christian principles, especially to love God and our neighbors as our self and being a good righteous people.

We have fallen so short of both protecting liberty for all, practicing righteousness, and protecting the practice of Christianity throughout the land. We have murdered over 63 million babies in the wombs. Every day we kill thousands. We are worse than Hitler who killed only seven million Jews. We are living during the American Holocaust. We have accepted the Supreme Court casting God and Christianity out of our public institutions. A teacher cannot pray with children or read the Holy Bible freely with our school children without being fired (religious persecution). A judge in Alabama was fired because he refused to remove a plaque of the Ten Commandments from the Court. A soldier cannot put a Christian bumper sticker on his vehicle and practice Christianity. America has lost all religious freedom in our public institutions due to evil and criminal rulings of the Supreme Court.

The Constitution protects Americans, including the unborn babies to live and not be murdered. The Supreme Court has deceitfully perverted the meaning of the Constitution by saying the unborn is not a human being just as it once said a black slave was not a human being. They have rejected the great premise our free society is built on, “all men are created equal,” by dehumanizing the baby.

This same Court has taken away religious liberty in our public institutions under the false and perverted policy of separation of church and state. Separation of church and state protects religious freedom from the State removing it anywhere. It means the State shall not make a National Church by favoring one denomination. It also means the State shall protect religious freedom everywhere and never prohibit it. The Supreme Court has committed treason by perverting the original meaning of the Constitution into very evil and oppressive rulings. They are also destroying the institution of marriage by legalizing homosexual marriages.

Mr. President we are not a great Nation anymore and you have not made us a great Nation by restoring wealth to Americans. We are not great because we have evil and wicked policies like abortion on demand and prohibiting the practice of Christianity in our schools, our State Government, and armed forces. We have driven millions of our children from God by our anti God schools. Our dishonor of God is evil. Our schools are just like communist atheist schools that reject Christ and Christianity.

Fornication is practiced throughout the land and the Federal Government encourages it by giving money to unwed mothers and taking it if they do get married. We are morally corrupt as a Nation and no longer a righteous, good Nation. We practice wicked policies before God, and yet we believe we are great? We have become a wicked Nation which I fear shall one day experience God's great judgment. We have forgotten God: "The wicked shall be turned into hell and all the nations that forget God." Psalm 9:17

Mr. President I know you just lack understanding of our Nation's history and what makes us great. Please drop the slogan "Keep America Great Again." The slogan is wrong. It supports all the wicked policies of America and pretends we are great when we are actually wicked as a Nation. We have a long way to go before we are great and good again. To be great again we must ban abortion entirely. We must restore the free practice of Christianity in our schools, State Government and the Armed Forces. We must ban all homosexual marriages. We must encourage marriage and discourage fornication throughout the Land. We must reject all communistic policies that encourage Americans to worship government rather than the Lord God of our Fathers. We must hold the Supreme Court accountable for the murder of 63 million Americans. The Court must be destroyed as it is and all judges impeached, because they support murder. A new Court must be created of at least 19 judges elected by the people with a veto on the court by Congress and the States of just 50%. The appointment system of life long terms does not work. The Supreme Court must be reformed. We must repent as a Nation and pray to God for mercy for our sins. I believe, Mr. President, that you should call for a Day of National Prayer and Fasting to repent of our sins and ask God for His mercy as President Abraham Lincoln did.

Thank you for your time to read my letter and consider these issues. I really think as you consider the bigger picture it would be wise to drop your new slogan "Keep America Great" and return to your old slogan "Make America Great Again".
